



INSTRUCTIONS TO THE CANDIDATES

INSTRUCTIONS TO BE READ CAREFULLY BY THE CANDIDATES

- Candidates are to report at the centre at least two (2) hours before the commencement of the examination. (Exam time: 12:00 noon – 2:30 pm)
- No candidate will be allowed to enter the examination centre without her/his Admit Card, valid ID proof, proper frisking and biometric verification. Frisking through Hand-Held Metal Detectors (HHMD) will be carried out at the entry gate by male/female guards separately. Candidates who follow a particular religion and wear customary dress will be required to report on time so that there is ample time for proper frisking. Follow Covid-19 protocols as far as applicable.
- Specially abled candidates must bring along with them requisite certificate from the appropriate authority and scribe related documents, if applicable. Prior permission should be sought from the respective DI/S(PE) of the opted district. In case a specially abled candidate requires a scribe, additional compensatory time of 50 minutes will be allowed for such candidates.
- The candidate is required to produce the admit card downloaded from the website and a valid original ID proof (Madhyamik Admit Card/Aadhar Card (with photograph)/PAN Card/ Voter's ID/Passport/Driving licence) for admission in the examination hall/room. A candidate without possession of the aforesaid documents shall under no circumstances, be permitted to appear for the said examination by the Centre-in-Charge.

5. In no way, will any venue be responsible for the safe custody of any prohibited / banned items carried by the candidates to the entrance of the exam centre.
6. Each candidate should carry her/his own black ball point pen to the venue, two copies of admit card downloaded from the website and an additional photograph, same as uploaded in the application form to be pasted on the attendance sheet.
7. Each candidate has been allocated a seat indicating her/his roll number. Candidates should find and occupy only the seat assigned to them. If any candidate is found to have changed her/his room or the seat on her/his own, other than the one allotted, her/his candidature shall be cancelled immediately and no plea would be entertained thereafter.
8. Any candidate arriving at the venue allotted to her/him after the commencement of the examination, shall not be permitted to appear for the examination.
9. Under no circumstances will candidates be allowed to carry the following items inside the centre: -
 - Any stationery item like textual material (printed or written), bits of paper, geometry / pencil box, plastic pouch, calculator, scale, writing pad, pen drives, log table, electronic pen/scanner, cardboard, water bottle etc.
 - Any communication device like mobile phones, bluetooth, earphones, microphones, pagers, health bands etc.
 - Any watch/wrist watch, camera, wallet, goggles, handbags, gold ornaments etc.
 - Having in possession any other banned/prohibited items which could be used for unfair means or for communicating with others in or outside the venue.
10. Smoking, chewing gutka, spitting or creating any such nuisances in the examination hall/room is strictly prohibited. No food items, or beverages like tea, coffee, cold drinks are allowed to be taken inside the examination room or consumed during examination hours.
11. No candidate, without the special permission of the invigilator concerned will be allowed to leave her/his seat or room of examination, until the entire duration of the examination is over.
12. At the end of the examination, candidates are instructed to hand over to the invigilator:
 - I. Original copy of the OMR answer sheet for TET-2022 (pink in colour)
 - II. One Downloaded and signed copy of her/his admit card

 - iii. A copy of the admit card signed by the invigilator.






He/ She is hereby appointed, on purely temporary basis, to the post of Excise Constable under the Malda Excise Division, West Bengal in the Scale of Pay, i.e., Pay Matrix Level-6 (Rs. 22700/- to Rs. 58500/-) as per West Bengal Services (Revision of Pay and Allowance) Rules, 2019 plus usual allowances as admissible under the existing rules with effect from the date they report for duty subject to the following conditions, viz:

1. That he/ she submits for the purpose of entry into the Government Service a declaration of his/ her age in prescribed form (obtainable from the office) along with the documents from the appropriate authority showing his/ her date of birth in support of his/ her declaration;
2. That he/ she takes oath or makes affirmation in the prescribed form (obtainable from the office) both in writing and orally before the appropriate authority;
3. That his/ her service shall be governed by all rules and regulations of the Government of West Bengal issued from time to time including the West Bengal Service (Duties, Rights and Obligations of the Government Employees) Rules, 1980;
4. That he/ she submits within a period of 3(three) months from the date of his/ her joining in the post of Excise Constable, his/ her first return showing his/ her assets as they stood on 1st January 2022 or his/ her year of joining and shall thereafter submit such statement every year within stipulated date as per existing rules;
5. That he/ she shall be liable to be transferred anywhere in the State of West Bengal as and when necessary in the interest of public service;
6. That he/ she shall have to undergo police training at such institute and for such period as may be fixed by the appropriate authority;
7. That no travelling expenses will be allowed for his/ her journey to join the post of Excise Constable.
8. In case of in-service candidate, he/ she shall submit Release Order from the appropriate authority prior to his joining.

Upon agreeing to observe the aforesaid conditions and/ or submission of documents, as aforesaid, he/ she will report to the office of the **Superintendent of Excise, Uttar Dinajpur** for joining to the post of Excise Constable **within 15 (Fifteen) days** from the date of receipt of this letter failing which this appointment letter will be treated as cancelled.

The Awardee is required to get admission and registration for regular and full time **M.Phil./Ph.D.** course in a University/Institution/College recognized by UGC at the first available opportunity **but not later than three years** from the date of issue of original award letter, i.e., . University/Institution/College is requested to process for award of JRF based on this letter, in accordance with the procedure available on www.ugc.ac.in/netjrf.

It may be noted that the fellowship amount shall be disbursed through Canara Bank to bank account of the Awardee (any bank) directly.
